Three ring binder: 1" D ring for 8 ½" x 11" paper handouts

- Drawing board: 19" x 25" x ½" foam core
- Drawing pad: Strathmore 500 series 18" x 24" assorted tints
- Charcoal: Winsor & Newton—medium grade, small box
- Charcoal pencils: General or Pitt (soft or medium)
- Erasers: An assortment-pink pearl, white, kneaded
- Chamois cloth
- Utility knife: Any kind
- Sanding block
- Large clips: To be used to hold drawing pad to foam core
- Ruler: 18" or 24"
- Wood Dowel: 1/8" diameter—sold in different lengths at art and hardware store
- Plumb line: Make this yourself. Take a piece of string two to three feet long and attach a weight such as a bolt or washer.
