MATERIALS LIST

- **Drawing Paper:** Pad of Strathmore Drawing Medium, 400 series, 80 lb., 14" by 17" or bigger is perfect. Canson is also good. *Do not use newsprint paper.*
- **Pencils:** H, HB, B. You can also bring a couple of brown/red colored pencil such as Indian red, Venetian red, burnt Sienna, Sanguine or similar. Good brands for colored pencils are Caran D'Ache or Faber Castell.
- **Kneaded eraser**
- **Plastic Eraser**
- **Pencil Sharpener**
- **Plumb Line:** (it can be found at any hardware store or make it yourself with a fishing weight and sewing thread.
