  - Bright Shader #4, #6
  - Liner #4
  - Round#2/0
  - Wash#1" in.
  - Stroke 3/4 in.
  - Stroke 1" in.

- Palette
- Palette knives
- Jars or plastic containers for mixing and saving paints
