

HALF-DAY AND 5-WEEK OPTION

- All courses are designed for full-time attendance. For greater flexibility, select 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. courses may be taken for half-day, 9 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. or 1:30 – 5 p.m. Courses generally feature more lecture and demonstration in the morning, and extended studio time and individual guidance in the afternoon. Information and demonstrations given during one portion of the day may not be repeated for the other half.
- Select 10-week evening courses may also be taken for five weeks, either in Session 1 or 2.
- If you begin a half-day or five-week course you may add the second half of the same course for the balance of the full-course tuition.

This six-week program is designed for artists and educators who desire constructive feedback on their artwork, as well as the support and interaction of an artistic community. Registration includes a private studio in the Samuel M.V. Hamilton Building, and individual critiques every Friday from a stellar ensemble of nationally and internationally known artists, including members of PAFA's acclaimed faculty. This summer's critics: Philadelphia-based artist, **Wilmer Wilson; Sharon Ewing**, Director of Gross-McCleaf Gallery; **Jan Baltzell**, artist & PAFA faculty member, **Jodi Throckmorton**, PAFA Curator of Contemporary Art; and artist & PAFA faculty member **Bruce Samuelson**. Lead critic **Neysa Grassi** will hold discussions, a group critique and field trips, based on the needs of the group.
