FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2014, THE ACADEMY WAS CHARGED A 0.4% FEE FOR THIS SERVICE. FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, THIS FEE WAS APPROXIMATELY \$66,000. IN ADDITION, THIS TRUST COMPANY PROVIDES A LINE OF CREDIT FOR THE ACADEMY; INTEREST EXPENSE PAID DURING THE YEAR FOR THIS LINE OF CREDIT WAS APPROXIMATELY \$70,000. ALTHOUGH THE TRUST COMPANY IN QUESTION CHARGES THE ACADEMY FOR ITS SERVICES, IT ALSO MADE SUBSTANTIAL GIFTS TO THE ACADEMY. THE NET CHARGES AFTER SUCH GIFTS RESULTED THE QUESTION OF THE TRUST COMPANY'S CHARGES IN THIS FEE BEING QUITE SMALL. TO THE ACADEMY WAS SUBMITTED TO THE FINANCE COMMITTEE, AND THEN TO THE FULL BOARD OF TRUSTEES. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE TRUST COMPANY'S CHARGES, THE TRUST COMPANY'S GIFTS TO THE ACADEMY, AND THE PERFORMANCE OF THE TRUST COMPANY, THE BOARD DECIDED THAT THE RELATIONSHIP WITH THE TRUST COMPANY WAS QUITE BENEFICIAL TO THE ACADEMY.
