COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS

Deborah Willis

As an artist, author and curator Deb Willis's art and pioneering research has focused on cultural histories envisioning the black body, women and gender. She is a celebrated photographer, acclaimed historian of photography, MacArthur and Guggenheim Fellow, and university professor and Chair of the Department of Photography & Imaging at the Tisch School of the Arts at New York University. Willis received the NAACP Image Award in 2014 for her co-authored book Envisioning Emancipation: Black Americans and the End of Slavery (with Barbara Krauthamer) and in 2015 for the documentary *Through a Lens Darkly*, inspired by her book Reflections in Black: A History of Black Photographers 1840 to the Present.

ALUMNI SERVICE AWARD Richard Watson

Established in 2015, this award is presented annually by the Alumni Council and recognizes alumni who have demonstrated a sustained commitment to their community. Richard J. Watson is an alumnus of the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts Certificate Program ('68). He is a multi-faceted artist who is widely recognized as a representational and collage artist who has to his credit many public and institutional murals throughout the city of Philadelphia. A seasoned songwriter and solo performer on guitar and banjo, he also produces one-of-a-kind, art-to-wear fashions. Watson devotes many hours to encouraging and advising younger artists by conducting workshops in schools and teaching as an adjunct instructor at PAFA.

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD

Moe Brooker

Established in 2003, this award is presented annually by the Alumni Council to an alum who has demonstrated outstanding artistic achievement. Collectively, the recipients reflect the diversity and talent of the alumni body. Moe Brooker is an alumnus of the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts Certificate Program ('63), and was a professor and critic at PAFA. His compositions are informed by discovery, invention, and the process of "making visible," revealing relationships between color and form, emotion and intellect, and faith in the divine and the human condition. He won several lifetime achievement awards, including the Governor's Award for Artist of the Year from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the Medal of Achievement from the Philadelphia Art Alliance. Brooker's work can be found in the permanent collections of institutions such as the Studio Museum in Harlem, the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, the Musée des Beaux-arts de l'Ontario, and the Philadelphia Museum of Art. Moe Brooker passed away on January 9, 2022 at the age of 81. Plans for a posthumous retrospective exhibition are underway at the Woodmere Art Museum in Philadelphia.
