Materials List

- Pencils and eraser
- 11 x 14 inch sketchbook
- Ruler
- Water-based media of the students' choice (watercolor/gouache/ink), including colors red, yellow, blue, black, and white. It is recommended that students bring any water-media materials that they already have and purchase supplies after watching the instructor's demonstrations if they wish to use different media.
- Water-media brushes –a variety of filberts, flats, and rounds, from very small round brushes to oneinch flats and filberts, recommended
- Pad of watercolor paper OR wet-media Bristol paper (not all Bristol is appropriate for WET media be sure to check at art store)
- Rags
- Water container
- Palette with wells for water-media
- Colored pencils or magic markers or Micron pens
